Zone X Introduction

Zone X Skeet is an organization formed in the Northwest to promote the growth of Skeet in the Northwest. To that end, the 2012 Zone X Skeet Championships is an open NSSA Registered Skeet Shoot for individuals in good standing with their associations. The Zone X Skeet Championships is not, however, an NSSA recognized Zone event and therefore will not provide Zone All-American points.

To make this shoot the best possible, this program has been mailed out to as many active shooters in the region as was feasible. If you know anyone who may be interested in attending who did not receive the program, please let me know and I will make sure they receive a copy. I have also included information on activities in the area to help you and your family plan your time here.

I would like to thank the Spokane Gun Club and the Missoula Trap & Skeet Club for hosting the previous two Zone X Championships which were some of the finest shoots in the Northwest. The Seattle Skeet and Trap Club is looking forward to continuing in this tradition.

Seattle Skeet & Trap Club

History



Seattle Skeet and Trap Club, Inc. began as the result of moving from Fort Lawton to Redmond and forming the Redmond Sportsmen's Association on May 14, 1928. A picture of the 1924 state trap shoot at Fort Lawton exists today. The name was changed to The Redmond Gun Club on May 13, 1950. Later, not to be outdone, the name was changed to Seattle Gun Club in the sixties and then to Seattle Skeet and Trap Club on January 5, 1972.

The Seattle Gun Club sold its property in Redmond to Cadman Sand & Gravel Company in 1958. As a condition of sale, a 30 year lease was signed. The Club operated until 1988 when Cadman needed the gravel under the club. A year-to-year lease was signed that ended in 1991. The last shoot held at the club was the 1991 Spring Open skeet championships held March 16 and 17, 1991. The next day, there was no sign of a gun club on the site as gravel mining had commenced.

After the Redmond closing, the Club's equipment was stored and a search committee was formed to locate property for a new club. The search for new property ended in June 1997 with the signing of a thirty-year lease on 25 acres located near Ravensdale owned by the King County Parks Department. Plans then were to build a clubhouse and seven combination skeet and trap fields. Construction started in March of 1999 when Jeff VanDenTop and his crew started clearing the land for the new club. Also in 1999, Seattle Skeet and Trap merged with the Boeing Employees Shotgun Sports Club (BESS) who also lost their club due to land sales by the Boeing corporation. This merger brought in a significant number of members, equipment and traditional shoots that live on today.

Today the club has a 2016 sq. ft. clubhouse, fully ADA accessible with restroom and shower facilities. The Club has 14 RV sites with water and electric and 4 others with just electric. There are six combination skeet and trap fields and a world class 5-stand with covered shooting stations. Member volunteers have completed a 13 station sporting clays course with covered shooting stations. There are current plans to update our trap and skeet machines, expand the sporting clays course to 23 stations, and build a storage building and club house expansion. The club is strong and growing!

Last year the Club hosted the NSCA Washington State Sporting Clays Championships and just held the 2012 WASCTP State Championships both with great success. The 2012 Washington State Skeet Championships being held at Seattle Skeet and Trap on July 20- 22nd will be the third Washington State Championships SST has hosted in 24 years.

The club has many registered Skeet, Trap and Sporting Clays shoots on its ranges each year with Continental and Skeet Leagues. The future is bright for Seattle Skeet and Trap, we hope you will attend the 2012 Zone X Championships at the club and see the progress for yourself!

 6. This shoot is limited to 75 shooters so pre-registration is strongly encouraged.
 7. Pre-registration should be mailed by August 1st to provide time to process and return confirmation.

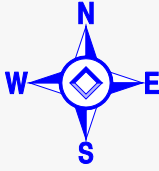

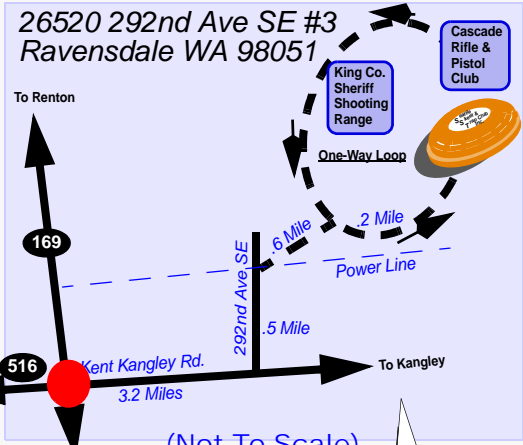

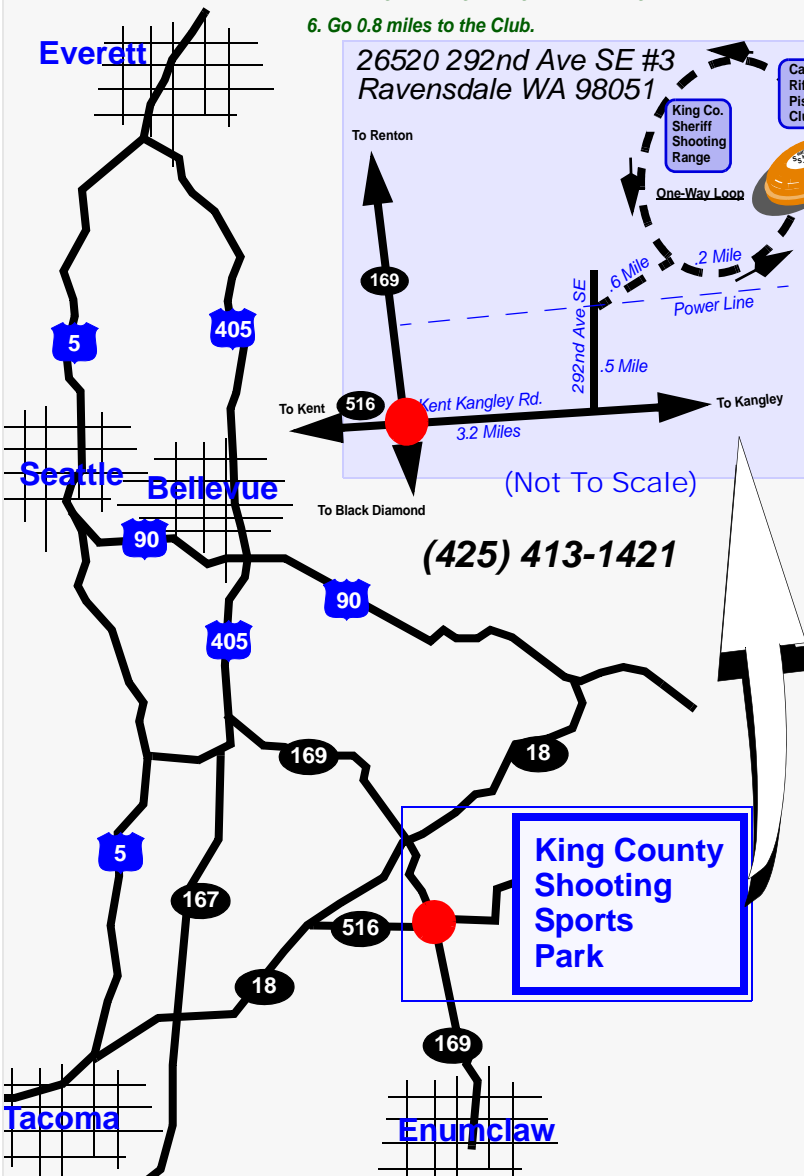
